2026-2027 Uniform Guidelines

Male Students

All items must be purchased at the online Pinewood School Store at Lands' End, located at www.landsend.com/school (school code: 900120635), or purchased through the Pinewood Uniform Buy-Back Program. All items must be worn as designed. *For convenience, the online store includes only the items/options listed below.* *** **See the last page for PK2**

Tops: Male students must wear one of the following from Lands' End:

- Polo (short or long sleeve) with logo: white, classic navy, blue, and gray heather
 - Approved polos include: mesh, interlock, tailored interlock, banded bottom, rapid dry
- Oxford (short or long sleeve) with crest: white, blue
- Pinpoint (short or long sleeve) shirt with crest: white, blue

**Students in PK3-Grade 1 may wear approved Pinewood PE t-shirts in lieu of other approved tops.

Bottoms: Male students must wear one of the following from Lands' End:

- Chino shorts (plain front in cotton or blend, active) or Elastic Waist Shorts: classic navy, khaki, arctic gray. **Shorts are required to be within 3 inches of the top of the knee. Shorts must not be too tight or short, and must be appropriately sized. No visible undergarments.**
- Chino Pants: classic navy, khaki, arctic gray
 - Approved pants include: stain-resistant plain front, iron knee blend plain front or elastic waist, perfect or active chino, tailored fit blend or stain-resistant fit
- Belts for males in grades 6-12 are optional with pants and shorts that have belt loops.

**Students in PK3-PK4 may wear approved Pinewood PE shorts, or sweatpants/track pants (no yoga pants) in lieu of other approved bottoms.

Optional Outerwear: All outerwear must be worn with either an approved polo, oxford or pinpoint/broadcloth shirt. Male students may wear any of the following outerwear from Lands' End with an approved collared shirt underneath:

- Sweater with logo/crest: classic navy, coal heather
 - Approved sweaters with logo include performance fine-gauge V-neck, fine gauge V-neck pullover or vest, performance zip-front cardigan, drifter V-neck pullover or vest, zip-front drifter cardigan
 - Approved sweaters with crest include: performance button-front cardigan, button-front drifter cardigan
- Fleece (half-zip or jacket) with logo: classic navy
- Performance ¼ zip with logo: classic navy
- Thermoplume jacket with logo: classic navy
- Blazer with crest (not available in youth sizes under 8): deep navy
- Crew sweatshirt with P.E. logo: classic navy
- Active Track Jacket with P.E. logo: classic navy
- Packable Rain Jacket (unlined & fleece lined) with logo: classic navy

All students are prohibited from wearing non-branded outerwear. However, they may wear such items (e.g. raincoats and winter coats) in between classes when moving outdoors between buildings *with the exception of hoodies*. We encourage the non-branded outerwear to be school colors- Navy, dark gray or charcoal, white, or columbia blue. For students seeking additional school-approved outerwear options, Pinewood partners with [BSN Sports](#) to offer team and general school spirit wear.

Shoes: Students are encouraged to exercise discretion in choosing footwear. Closed toe shoes are recommended. Beach-style flip-flops, slippers/bedroom shoes, slides or “shower shoes” are not permitted.

Additional Notes

Revealing, excessively short, or tight attire is not permitted. See-through clothing is not permitted. Undershirts visible through shirts must be light-colored and may not show any visible logos or prints. Other undergarments may not be visible.

Spirit Day: Each Friday is a Pinewood Spirit Day. All students may choose to wear official Pinewood gear to show their school spirit: Pinewood jerseys, sweatshirts (no hoodies), t-shirts, etc. which represent an athletic team, academic organization, community service project, or fine arts events. Students may wear shorts/pants/jeans with a Pinewood shirt. Athletic shorts/pants, loungewear, or leggings are not to be worn as bottoms. Jeans may not have any rips, holes, or frays. The shorts and pants do not need to abide by the bottom color guidelines. No swim bottoms.

Hats: Hats cannot be worn in school buildings. However, they may wear such items (i.e. cold-weather gear) in between classes when moving outdoors between buildings.

Lanyards: Lanyards must be breakaway.

No hoodies are allowed.

Female Students

All items must be purchased at the online Pinewood School Store at Lands' End, located at www.landsend.com/school (school code: 900120635), or purchased through the Pinewood Uniform Buy-Back Program. All items must be worn as designed. *For convenience, the online store includes only the items/options listed below.* *** **See the last page for PK2**

Tops: Female students must wear one of the following from Lands' End:

- Polo (short or long sleeve) with logo: blue, classic navy, white (all grades, PK3-12), and gray heather
 - Approved polos include feminine fit mesh or interlock, mesh or interlock, banded bottom, knit peter pan polo in plain, ruffle front or collar, rapid dry
- Pinpoint or broadcloth shirt with crest: white, blue
- No Gape Shirt (stretch, long sleeve or $\frac{3}{4}$ sleeve) with crest: white
- Oxford (short or long sleeve) with crest: white, blue
- Peter Pan button front knit top with crest: blue, white
- Peter Pan (short sleeve collared or piped collar broadcloth) button-up shirt with crest: white/classic navy

**Students in PK3-Grade 1 may wear approved Pinewood PE t-shirts in lieu of other approved tops.

Dresses, Jumpers and Bottoms: Female students must wear either a dress, jumper, skirt, skort, shorts or pants from Lands' End with an approved top. Dresses, jumpers, skirts, and skorts may not have the length shortened or rolled at the waist.

- Jumper with crest: classic navy, gray, clear blue plaid, charcoal heather
 - Approved jumpers include: top-of-the-knee solid and plaid and Ponte pleated
 - An approved shirt must be worn under the jumpers.
- Dress (short or long sleeve) with logo: blue, classic navy, charcoal heather,
 - Approved dresses include: mesh polo (PK3-8), knit ruffle bottom (PK3-8) and Ponte dress
- Skirt: khaki, classic navy, gray, clear blue plaid, charcoal heather
 - Approved skirts include A-line, pleated, box pleat, Poly/Cotton, Ponte pleat. All skirts must be top-of-the-knee or below-the-knee styles only.
- Skort: khaki, classic navy, clear blue plaid, gray, charcoal heather
 - Approved skorts include chino and pleated. All skorts must be top-of-the-knee or below-the-knee styles only.
- Shorts: arctic gray, classic navy, khaki
 - Approved shorts include: plain front chino, stretch chino Bermuda, elastic waist, active chino
- Pants: classic navy, khaki, arctic gray
 - Approved pants include plain front stretch or blend chino, elastic waist blend chino, woven stretch pencil leg chino

Female students in PK3 - Grade 12 may wear tights or leggings **under any dresses, jumpers, skirts or skorts. Leggings are not to be worn separately as pants and must be opaque solid colored blue, black, white, or gray leggings or tights under plaid skirts, skorts, or dresses. Athletic bottoms, such as sweatpants, are not allowed under skirts, skorts or dresses. Students may wear opaque print or opaque solid colored leggings or tights with blue, gray, or tan uniform skirts, skorts, and dresses. The leggings or tights do not need to be from Lands' End. Students may not wear athletic attire on school days. On Friday Spirit Wear Days, students may only wear leggings with uniform skirts, skorts and

dresses. Students may not wear leggings with a shirt or sweatshirt only. **All skirts, skorts, shorts, dresses and jumpers are required to be within 3 inches from the top of the knee or below.**

****Lower School students may wear patterned or colorful leggings or tights under any dresses, jumpers, skirts, or skorts. Due to the nature of play, shorts or leggings must be worn under dresses.**

****Students in PK3-PK4 may wear approved Pinewood PE shorts, skorts, or sweatpants/track pants (no yoga pants) in lieu of other approved bottoms.**

Optional Outerwear: Female students may wear outerwear from Lands' End with an approved collared shirt underneath or PE shirt for Lower School.

- Sweaters with logo: classic navy, coal heather, white
 - Approved sweaters with logo include: performance or cotton fine gauge cardigan, v-neck or vest. v-neck drifter pullover or vest, zip-front or button-front drifter cardigan
 - Approved sweaters with crest include: performance button- or zip-front cardigan.
- Blazer with crest: deep navy
- Crew Sweatshirt with P.E. logo: classic navy
- Fleece (half-zip pullover or jacket) with logo: classic navy, dark charcoal
- Performance ¾ zip with logo: classic navy
- Thermoplume jacket with logo: classic navy
- Insulated vest with logo: true navy (discontinued)
- Active Track Jacket with P.E. logo: classic navy
- Packable Rain Jacket (unlined or fleece lined) with logo: classic navy

All students are prohibited from wearing non-branded outerwear. However, they may wear such items (e.g. raincoats and winter coats) in between classes when moving outdoors between buildings *with the exception of* hoodies. We encourage the non-branded outerwear to be school colors- Navy, dark gray or charcoal, white, or columbia blue. For students seeking additional school-approved outerwear options, Pinewood partners with [BSN Sports](#) to offer team and general school spirit wear.

Shoes: Students are encouraged to exercise discretion in choosing footwear. Closed toe shoes are recommended. Beach-style flip-flops, slippers/bedroom shoes, slides or “shower shoes” are not permitted.

Additional Notes

Revealing, excessively short, or tight attire is not permitted. See-through clothing is not permitted. Visible undergarments (including halter-style undergarments) are not permitted.

Spirit Day: Each Friday is a Pinewood Spirit Day. All students may choose to wear official Pinewood gear to show their school spirit: Pinewood jerseys, sweatshirts (no hoodies), t-shirts, etc. which represent an athletic team, academic organization, community service project, or fine arts event. Students may wear shorts/pants/jeans with a Pinewood shirt. Athletic shorts/pants, loungewear, or leggings are not to be worn as bottoms. Jeans may not have any rips, holes, or frays. Please refer to dress code guidelines in the Student Handbook for additional information. The shorts and pants do not need to abide by the bottom color guidelines. No swim bottoms.

Hats: Hats cannot be worn in school buildings. However, they may wear such items (i.e. cold-weather gear) in between classes when moving outdoors between buildings.

Lanyards: Lanyards must be breakaway.

No hoodies are allowed.

Physical Education Uniforms – Male and Female Students

All items must be purchased at the online Pinewood School Store at Lands' End, located at www.landsend.com/school (school code: 900120635), or purchased through the Pinewood Uniform Buy-Back Program. *For convenience, the online store includes only the items/options listed below.* PE is held twice a week. This applies to Lower School and Middle School PE and High School weight training.

PK3 – Grade 5:

- Students may wear Physical Education (P.E.) uniforms for the entire school day on their designated P.E. days.
- The current P.E. uniform (tops and bottoms) includes an approved Lands' End t-shirt, polo or crew sweatshirt, track jacket, shorts (mesh short for toddler sizes; athletic shorts for all other sizes), skorts, or sweatpants/track pants (no yoga pants) with the Pinewood Athletic "P" logo.. Female students may wear the athletic skort with the Athletic "P" logo. Students must wear tennis shoes.

Grades 6-12 (includes High School PE weight-training classes):

- Students will not wear P.E. uniforms during the school day and will change at their allotted PE class or weight training time.
- P.E. uniforms (tops and bottoms) must be purchased from the Pinewood School Store on the Lands' End website and must include an approved shirt, polo, crew sweatshirt, track jacket shorts, skort or sweatpants/track pants (no leggings or yoga pants) with the Pinewood Athletic "P" logo. Students must wear tennis shoes. Choices include warm and cold weather PE attire. All PE attire must conform with dress code expectations and may not be revealing or excessively short and may not have a visible midriff. Shorts must be mid thigh or below.

P.E. Uniform Choices from Lands' End:

- Long-sleeve or short-sleeve t-shirt or polo with P.E. logo: blue, classic navy, gray heather, white or soapstone
 - Approved t-shirts and polos include:
 - Females: feminine fit essential (long sleeve only), active tee, rapid dry active polo
 - Males: essential t-shirt (short and long sleeve), active tee, rapid dry active polo
- Crew Sweatshirt with P.E. logo: classic navy
- Shorts (mesh athletic) with P.E. logo: classic navy
- Active Skort (females only) with P.E. logo: classic navy
- Sweatpants or Active Track pants with P.E. logo: classic navy
- Track Jacket with P.E. logo: classic navy

Field Trip Uniforms – Male and Female Students

All items must be purchased at the online Pinewood School Store at Lands' End, located at www.landsend.com/school (school code: 900120635), or purchased through the Pinewood Uniform Buy-Back Program.

Middle and High School students wear uniforms on all field trips unless the trip coordinator tells them otherwise (i.e. if they have to wear dressy attire or athletic attire).

Lower School students will wear uniforms on field trips. Teachers may request students to wear PE uniform shirts or a specific uniform shirt color.

SCISA Events require no shorts or jeans at SCISA events.

Discounted Uniforms:

Join the Pinewood Prep uniforms: buy, sell, trade group on Facebook or stop by the Front Office and visit the donated uniform bins. The items in the Panther Den are \$15 for fleece and jackets, \$30 for blazers and \$8 each for all other items. During the summer, the Panther Den is open from 9 a.m. - 2 p.m. Monday-Thursday. The bins are accessible during the school year Monday-Friday 8 a.m.-4 p.m.

Backpacks:

Students may choose a backpack of their choice, however, there are Lands' End backpacks available.

Female PK2 Students - ONLY

Tops: Female students must wear one of the following from any brand:

- Polo (short or long sleeve): classic navy or white
- Plain t-shirt (short or long sleeve): classic navy or white

Dresses, Jumpers and Bottoms: Female students must wear either a dress, jumper, skirt, skort, shorts or pants from any brand with an approved top.

- Jumper: classic navy, gray, clear blue plaid (Lands' End brand only), charcoal heather (Lands' End brand only)
 - An approved shirt must be worn under the jumpers.
- Polo Dress (short or long sleeve): classic navy
- Skirt: khaki, classic navy, clear blue plaid (Lands' End brand only), charcoal heather (Lands' End brand only)
- Skort: khaki, classic navy, clear blue plaid (Lands' End brand only), charcoal heather (Lands' End brand only)
- Shorts: classic navy, khaki
 - Approved shorts may be athletic mesh material.
- Pants: classic navy, khaki
 - Approved pants may include sweatpants/track pants.

****Students in PK2 may wear tights or leggings under any dresses, jumpers, skirts or skorts. Leggings are not to be worn separately as pants. The leggings or tights may be colored or patterned. Due to the nature of play, shorts or leggings must be worn under dresses.**

****All items of clothing must be free from any other brand logo. Items do not need to have the Pinewood logo, crest or athletic P present.**

Male PK2 Students - ONLY

Tops: Male students must wear one of the following from any brand:

- Polo (short or long sleeve): classic navy or white
- Plain t-shirt (short or long sleeve): classic navy or white

Bottoms: Male students must wear either shorts or pants from any brand with an approved top.

- Shorts: classic navy, khaki
 - Approved shorts can be mesh material.
- Pants: classic navy, khaki
 - Approved pants may include sweatpants/track pants.

****All items of clothing must be free from any other brand logo. Items do not need to have the Pinewood logo, crest or athletic P present.**

PK2 Students - ONLY

Outerwear: Students do not need to purchase any additional outerwear, and can wear their preference in style and color. We encourage the non-branded outerwear to be school colors- Navy, dark gray or charcoal, white, or columbia blue. **Shoes:** Students are encouraged to exercise discretion in choosing footwear. Beach-style flip-flops or "shower shoes" are not permitted. Close toed shoes are recommended.
