

Dual Enrollment at Pinewood Preparatory School

Pinewood students in grades 11 and 12 who meet specific requirements may enroll in Dual Enrollment courses that allow them to meet Pinewood graduation requirements and also earn college credit through the School's partnership with Charleston Southern University. As a regionally accredited university, credits earned at CSU usually transfer to other higher education institutions; however, students should check with the individual institution, as each institution has its own policy on transfer/acceptance of credits.

Dual Enrollment courses are typically identified during spring scheduling and are noted in the Upper School Curriculum Guide, but occasionally a course is added during the summer. prior to the first day of classes at Pinewood, the course fee and additional registration information are shared with parents of students who are enrolled in courses that qualify for dual enrollment.

Students enrolled in designated courses will be given the opportunity to register with CSU during the first few weeks of the school year. Students must complete a CSU Transcript Request Form and pay for transcripts at the conclusion of the course.
