SUMMARY:

Perform a wide variety of facility, infrastructure, and utility maintenance, repair and renovation tasks at the semi-skilled level. A flexible work schedule with some overtime is required.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Must be able to successfully perform the following essential duties and other duties as may be assigned.

- General maintenance of the school buildings and grounds.
- Identify supplies, equipment, machinery, etc required to perform the job.
- Operate a variety of shop machinery and equipment such as complex hand/power tools and pressure washers.
- Must be able to work alone.
- The capability of successfully performing tasks associated with traditional building trades.
