Requirements

To be named a Middle School Global Scholar at the end of 8th grade, students will:

- Attend class trips during years enrolled at Pinewood Preparatory School.
- Complete a minimum of fifteen hours of community service per year or forty-five over the course of middle school. Community service is defined as "experiences in the communities beyond Pinewood Preparatory School."
- Participate in six Global Studies Middle School Enrichments, or two per year of Pinewood enrollment. Several options will be available each quarter and Drama students may count second semester as one if they choose a global piece to perform at the drama competition.
- Complete leadership research paper in 8th grade.
